

## White Wines

(Glass / Bottle)

- Salmon Creek White Zinfandel** 4.75 / 21  
Very light strawberry flavors, this wine is great with or without food and has a great finish that leaves you wanting more.
- Salmon Creek Chardonnay** 4.75 / 21  
Boasting an impressive range of flavors from the expected buttered oak overtones to the fresh, fruit flavors of apple, pear, citrus and melon, leaving a lasting palate impression.
- Beringer Napa Valley Chardonnay** 26  
This Chardonnay has hints of pear, oak and tropical fruit for a classic bouquet.
- Guenoc Langtry Chardonnay** 24  
Flavors of pear and tropical fruit are matched with oak and butter. This chardonnay is so good you'll want to find out where Lake County is.
- Four Bears Sauvignon Blanc** 7.50 / 26  
Rich and complex wine with aromas of grapefruit, citrus and tropical fruit. This wine is perfect with dinner or after you've put the cubs to bed.
- Oakley Four Whites** 24  
Adventurous blend of grapes make for unique zesty citrus fruits, ripe flavors and great acidity.
- Next Riesling** 6 / 24  
This fun, fruity wine has hints of peach, honey and lemon zest with just the right amount of acidity. You'll like it so much you'll be begging for the NEXT bottle.
- Chateau St. Jean Gewürztraminer** 29  
This wine has hints of red apple and spice, and finishes with flavors of honey and light citrus.
- Norton Cosecha Tardia** 36  
This late harvest chardonnay has a smooth flavor with touches of honey. Perfect alone or with dessert.
- King Estate Pinot Gris** 8.50 / 32  
The pineapple, pear and citrus flavor make this wine the king of pinot gris.

## Red Wines

(Glass / Bottle)

- Salmon Creek Cabernet Sauvignon** 4.75 / 21  
A medium berry bouquet wine that leaves the palate with a surprisingly bold chocolate, berry and somewhat tannic finish.
- NxNW Cabernet** 46  
With a beautiful blend of red fruit, caramel and chocolate, this richly structured wine is not for the birds!
- Arnold Palmer Cabernet** 8 / 30  
Flavors of red fruit pomegranate and chocolate make this cabernet a hole-in-one.
- Greg Norman Pinot Noir** 38  
Aromas of sweet strawberry, rose petal and tomato vine are subtle and highlighted by mushroom nuances delivering a smooth mouthfeel and lingering silky tannings.
- Salmon Creek Merlot** 4.75 / 21  
Amazingly fruity with a touch of bubble gum and a peppery note in the nose.
- Franciscan Merlot** 40  
This complex merlot is layered with plum, currants, vanilla and sage. Who'd believe it was originally made by monks?
- Simi Zinfandel** 38  
Simi, order a bottle Simi today.
- Melanto Terrace Zinfandel** 28  
Full bodied, jammy berry flavors with hints of vanilla and cedar spices.
- Sin Zin Zinfandel** 32  
A fun wine with ripe berries and spice, a sweet uplifted strawberry on the palate.
- Taz Goat Rock Syrah** 46  
This big bad Syrah is reminiscent of a great cab with flavors of cherry, pomegranate and pepper. A bottle of this syrah will really bring out the devil in you.
- Coppola Diamond Claret** 38  
This wonderful claret is a blend of cabernet sauvignon, verdot, merlot, malbec and cabernet franc. Its plum and blackberry aromas are so nice even the Godfather will drink it.
- Malbec Bianchi** 40  
Luxurious black fruits, deep garnet velvet tannins, spicy smoked plums with a full rich finish.

### Harp 5.00

Northern Ireland's number one lager Harp is brewed using golden barley and the choicest hops to give a smooth satisfying lager taste.

### Fat Tire Amber Ale 4.50
